QUESTIONS TO GUIDE YOUR EXPLORATION

1. The Central Premise: Is Belief a Matter of Evidence?

- *What do you think about the book’s central claim that the existence of God could be supported by scientific evidence?*
- *Does this shift your view of how faith and science can interact—or are they still fundamentally different ways of knowing?*

2. The “Great Reversal” of Science

- *The authors argue that science, once a challenge to belief, is now swinging back toward God. Do you find this idea compelling or problematic?*
- *Have you noticed a difference in how scientists (or people in general) talk about belief today compared to 20–30 years ago?*

3. Fine-Tuning and the Improbable Universe

- *Which scientific discovery or idea presented in the book did you find most surprising?*
- *Do you find the fine-tuning argument persuasive? Why or why not?*

- *If the universe seems fine-tuned for life, what explanations seem most plausible to you—chance, necessity, design?*

5. Personal Reactions and Reflections

- *Did this book confirm or challenge any of your existing beliefs—about God, science, or meaning?*
- *Have you ever wrestled with reconciling your worldview (religious or secular) with scientific understanding?*

6. Science and Spirituality Today

- *Why do you think there's growing interest among young people in spirituality, even as trust in institutions declines?*
- *Do you think it's possible for a scientist to be a person of faith without compromising intellectual integrity?*

7. The Scientists Behind the Ideas

- *Were you surprised to learn how many Nobel Prize winners or prominent scientists hold religious or metaphysical beliefs?*
- *Do you think public perception of scientists reflects this complexity—or leans too heavily toward one stereotype (atheist/materialist)?*

8. Faith, Evidence, and Public Discourse

- *How should conversations about science and faith take place in public life—in schools, media, politics?*
- *Does a book like this help bridge understanding or deepen divides? Why?*
